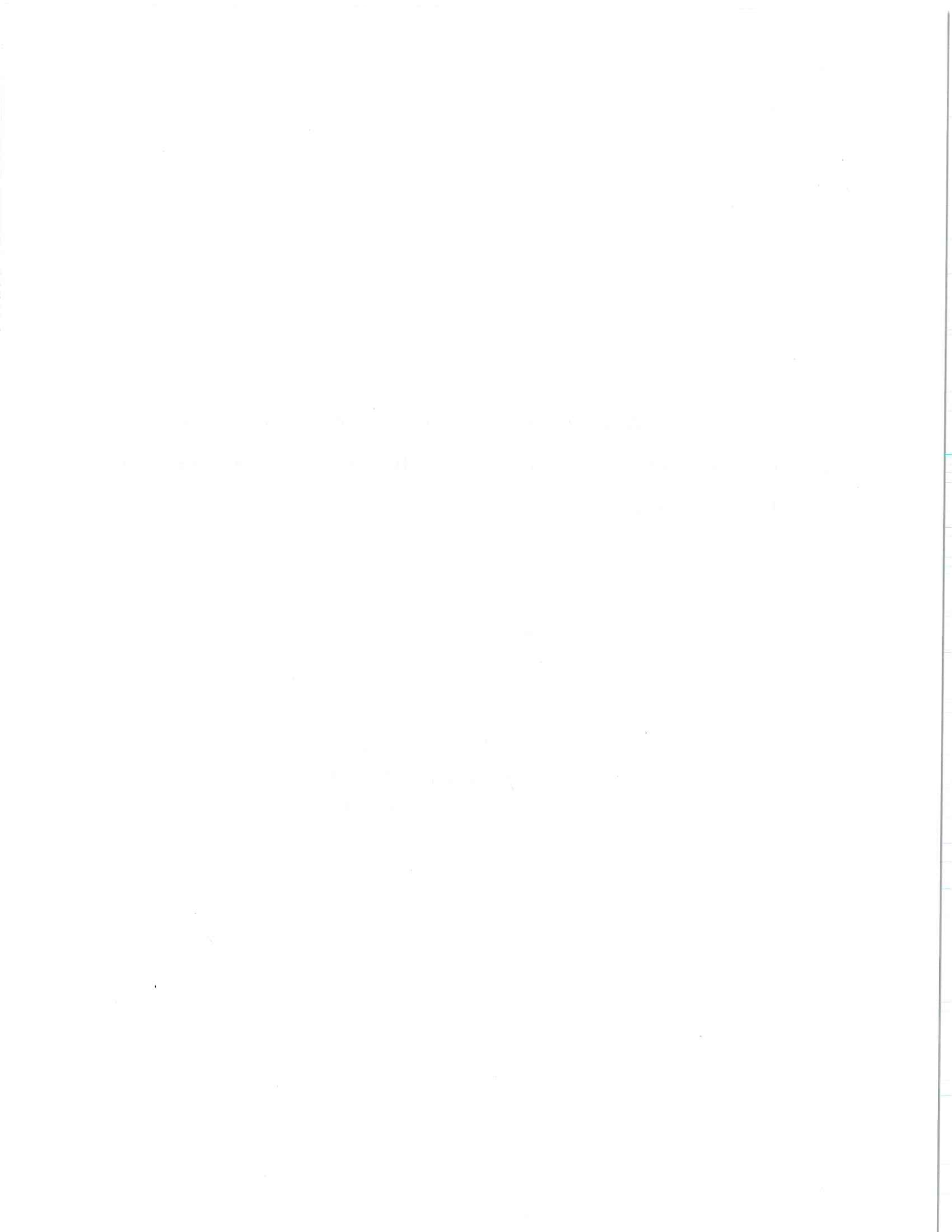

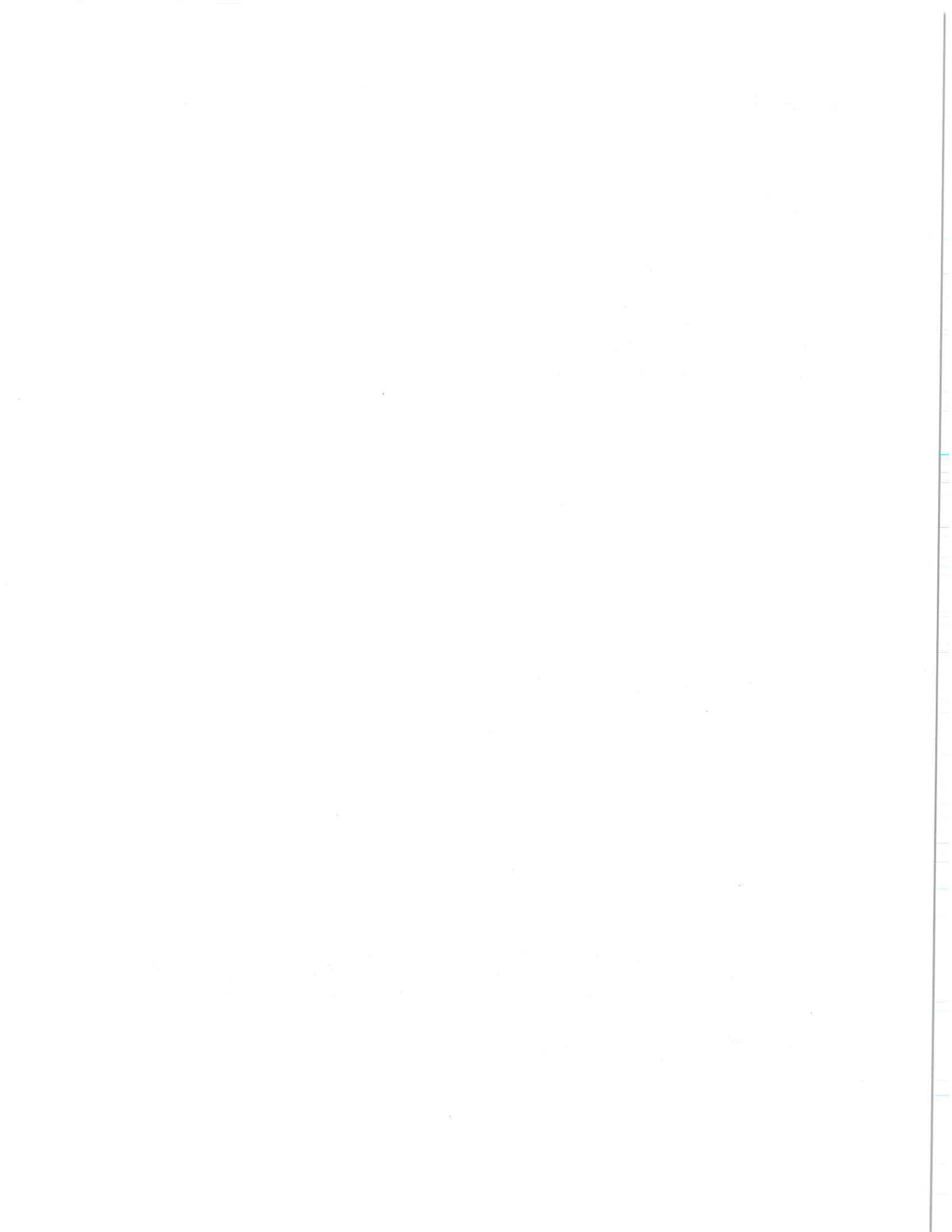

Amending O. Reg. 95/20

(ORDER UNDER SUBSECTION 7.0.2 (4) OF THE ACT - STREAMLINING
REQUIREMENTS FOR LONG-TERM CARE HOMES)

- 1. The title of Ontario Regulation 95/20 is amended by striking out “ORDER UNDER SUBSECTION 7.0.2 (4) OF THE ACT – ”.**
- 2. The Regulation is amended by striking out the portion before Schedule 1.**
- 3. The Regulation is amended by adding the following before Schedule 1:**

Terms of Order

- 1. The terms of this Order are set out in Schedule 1.**
- 4. Section 2 of the Regulation is revoked.**
- 5. (1) Section 3 of the Regulation is amended by striking out the portion before subparagraph i and substituting the following:**

Same

3. Despite any requirement set out in the LTCHA or Ontario Regulation 79/10 (General), made under that Act, or any other statute, regulation, order or policy, licensees shall and are authorized to do the following, or are not required to do the following, as the case may be:

- (2) Subparagraphs i and ii of section 3 of the Regulation are revoked.**
