As you are aware, on February 13, 2020, the Minister of Long-Term Care issued a Minister's Directive for the use of Glucagon, Severe Hypoglycemia, and Unresponsive Hypoglycemia with an effective date of April 15, 2020.

In light of the Covid-19 pandemic and the demands it has put on long-term care homes the April 15, 2020 effective date for the Directive was extended.

Commencing June 30, 2020, Long-Term Care Inspectors will begin ensuring homes are in compliance with the Minister's Directive.
