## RE: COVID-19: Long-term care preparedness plan – PPE Supply

We are writing in follow up to government announcements earlier this month regarding the <u>fall preparedness plan for the long-term care sector</u>.

As part of the fall preparedness planning, the Ontario government has announced that all long-term care homes will have access to an up to eight-week supply of personal protective equipment (PPE). This is a one-time commitment to provide all homes with needed PPE to support infection prevention and control practices, and to be prepared in the case of outbreaks. This supply is currently available for homes to order. As well, the province will continue to top up supplies of PPE in emergency situations, as per the current practice.

Attached you will find detailed guidance on how to place orders, as well as frequently asked questions.

In regard to N95s, please note that the Directive 5, which directs provision of N95 respirators to health care workers and regulated health professionals, has been amended as of October 8th (linked here). A questions and answers document is available to provide further detail (linked here). This communication sets out details of the currently available models and how long-term care homes may access the supply of N95s to meet reasonable requirements in the context of the updated Directive 5.

As a reminder, long-term care homes should continue maintaining their own supply chains and the Ontario Together <u>portal</u> includes a list of Ontario companies and business associations that are ready to supply PPE and can aid in this objective.

Finally, we continue to emphasize the need for responsible stewardship of PPE in alignment with Ontario Health guidance:
